

New Referral Process for Non-routine Breast Health Care in Southern Saskatchewan

Key Changes Effective December 11, 2024:

1. New Referral Form: A single referral form has been created for both the Regina Breast Health Centre and the Regina Breast Assessment Centre. This form must be used for all referrals moving forward.

2. Pooled Referral Model: Surgeons at the Regina Breast Health Centre will now utilize a pooled referral model. Direct referrals to surgeons are no longer required. If a specific surgeon is requested, it can be indicated on the new referral form.

3. Imaging Referrals: For imaging, imaging consults, or imaging-related procedures at the Regina Breast Assessment Centre, the new Breast Health Centre form must be completed. Patients referred to the Breast

Assessment Centre may also be directed to a breast surgeon through the pooled referral system if deemed appropriate.

4. Patient Referrals Based on Location: To ensure patients are seen at the Breast Health Centre closest to their residence:

- Patients living south of Davidson, Saskatchewan should be referred to the Regina Breast Health Centre.
- Patients living north of Davidson, Saskatchewan should be referred to the Saskatoon Breast Health Centre.
